Chess Club (Thursdays 3:30-4:30) -- A lot of interest, Optional

competitions for the students are coming up

Sphero Robotics (Fridays 8:00-8:40) -- Joanna Monson reported on this program, will be 4 sessions this year

Blended and Digital Learning - Definitions --Muir is using IReady as part of their digital learning goals, and Blended learning helps kids learn to problem solve in their own way without as much adult support

Seven Survival Skills- what teachers are implementing throughout the year Teachers are currently working on Collaboration across networks – Teams

\_\_\_\_\_Teams App helps teachers to collaborate and gain support in implementing the Blended and Digital Learning models

ILP's – Feedback on the Student-Led Conferences --CC members gave positive feedback on ILP's effectiveness, discussed how to keep the conference time with teachers down to 5 minutes. Principal reported that nearly 100% of students participated in ILPs.
